	Create pictures using 2D and 3D shapes.		What is an astronaut? Draw and talk about it to your grown up. Can your grownup record what you say?		How do they travel to space? Use a box to create your transport! Bring it into school! 3 afternoons.
	Use your toys to make some 3D models.		Talk about who Neil Armstrong is and share your portrait with a grownup – can your grownup record what you say?		

	Create your clock, talk about the numbers on the clock.		Using the front cover of 'The Way Back Home' talk about the alien and the boy. Can your grownup record what you say? What do they look like? What do they like to do?		
	Filling and emptying containers using the language of full, empty, half empty, nearly full etc.		Using the blurb (the back cover) can you tell your grown up what the blurb is? Can you think of a story to finish it off? Think about how he got there, what he saw and what happened...who was on that moon with him? Have a go at writing some of your story ideas.		
	Use your toys or objects to find one more or one less.
