


Math's tasks week beginning 13th July 2020


Write lots of random numbers from 1-100 (or beyond if you want a challenge!) on small paper, mix them up, then hang them on your washing line in the correct order.



Use chalk or stones to draw a hopscotch in your garden. Write numbers from the 5 times table to call, then add or multiply them as you jump!




Make a maths robot out of junk boxes. Label him with the 3D shape names for the junk boxes you use for the body parts. Add +, -, x, ÷, to the front then ask an adult to help you cut out a mouth. Write number sentences on small bits of paper to feed him. Try to use all the maths symbols.



Investigate: What is heavier?
A cup of water or a cup of cereals?
What else can you put in a cup that will be heavier or lighter than the cup of water?



Collect 40 small items (eg- stones, pennies, beans,) draw 4 large circles with chalk on the pavement. If you split all 40 items into the circles, how many are in each equally? Try with 2 circles. What would the equation look like?



Make some armpit fudge! In a zipper food bag add $\frac{1}{2}$ a cup of icing sugar, a large spoonful of butter, 2 small spoonful's of cream cheese, a few drops of vanilla extract and 2 small spoonful's of cocoa powder. Zip it up then squash it up under your armpit! When it's all mixed together, empty the bag into a bowl and enjoy your armpit fudge!
