<u>Literacy</u>	<p><u>Writing a non-chronological report</u></p> <p>During the Spring Term Year 2 have been learning about Heroes and Heroines.</p> <p>Over the next couple of weeks, the children will need to pick a type of job role in which employees are represented as a hero or heroine such as a nurse, doctor, firefighter, explorer or a famous person and to write an informative non chorological report.</p>	

	<p><u>What you will need to include -</u> The features of a non-chronological report include some of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An eye-catching heading in a large font • An introductory <u>paragraph</u> • Text split up into paragraphs and each paragraph on a different aspect of the subject • Sub-headings for each paragraph • Usually written in <u>present tense</u> • Pictures of the subject • Captions under each picture to explain what is in the picture • Lists of facts in bullet points • Boxes containing interesting individual facts to grab the attention of the reader <p>Inside the pack I have included an example of a Non- chronological report linked to the famous explorer Christopher Columbus, a success criteria sheet, a planning sheet and a writing template so your child can write up their report in best handwriting using their knowledge of capital letters, commas, question marks, bullet points, contractions and apostrophes.</p>
